



Hurricane Preparation Timeline

Start monitoring & check supplies, including for pets
Finish any repairs to home exterior & car
Restock necessities including enough medication for 2 weeks
Check generator is working & have CO2 monitor to keep nearby inside
Review evac zone & plan

Gas up your vehicle & fuel cans for generators
Fill propane tanks
Refill saved bottles with filtered water
Clean out fridge/ freezer & freeze ice packs & refilled water bottles
Charge power packs, radios, etc. & swap any batteries
Discuss plans with your job

Put toilet paper/ documents in waterproof bags
Raise furniture/ electronics on pallets & cover with tarps
Move additional vehicle to higher ground if in a flood/ storm surge prone area
Notify a neighbor & family member outside of area where you'll be
Evacuate today if possible

Trim loose limbs
Store any outdoor furniture, tools, etc.
Make sure others are aware & see if neighbors need help, especially anyone more vulnerable
Keep monitoring advisories frequently from NHC, local meteorologists, & emergency officials

Board up windows/ doors that are not impact/ hurricane rated
Have a way to turn off natural gas at the meter
Schedule payments for any bills due within 2 weeks
Get cash to have on hand
Straighten up house to ease potential storm clean up
Wash laundry/dishes

Evacuate as early as possible if you are going to
If you live in a manufactured/ mobile home, **DO NOT STAY** - evacuate or go to a local shelter
Fill bathtubs/ containers with water for bathing/ hygiene
Pack coolers & hunker down
